Member Data Subject Statement

St. Vincent de Paul Society (**SVP**) processes your Personal Data (as defined by the Data Protection Act 2018) for the purposes of:

- a) providing any Member services or Member Benefits in accordance with our membership agreement;
- b) providing you with information about the activities of SVP and its partners; (partners include the David Young Charity and organisation members of the Vincentian Family)
- c) administration and archiving in relation to your membership of SVP and any donations that you may make;
- d) statutory and regulatory compliance;
- e) processing any enquiries or complaints raised by you and responding to any communications from you;
- f) transferring to third parties with whom we have a relationship; e.g. to a mailing house to send you the Vincentian Concern magazine (The SVP use Johnson Mailing)
- g) transferring to HMRC in respect of any Gift Aid claims; and
- h) sending electronic information about the SVP, including marketing and fundraising activities

We collect Personal Data from you when you communicate with us by any media. We use 'Legitimate Interest' as the 'Lawful Basis' to process your personal data under the DP act.

The SVP does not use your personal data to send you direct marketing about other charities or organisations (other than stated above under partners), we will only send SVP members information about SVP activities, however, If you would like us to cease to process your Personal Data for the purposes of direct marketing, please write to the Head of Compliance at St. Vincent de Paul Society, 55 Westminster Bridge Road, London, SE1 7JB.

Please note it is possible your Personal Data may be transferred outside of the European Economic Area where data protection laws are not as strong as within the EEA. If you have any concerns in relation to such transfers, please write to the person specified above at the same address.
